

## Old Varieties: Gibber Italicus Frill

### Standard & Scale of Points

<b>Position:</b>	In the form of a figure 7	20 points
<b>Head:</b>	Small and fine, narrow skull, small beak, no frills	6 points
<b>Neck:</b>	Long and horizontal, no frills	15 points
<b>Legs:</b>	Long and stiff, thighs exposed	15 points
<b>Wings:</b>	Long and close to the body	6 points
<b>Shoulders:</b>	High, with symmetrical frills	10 points
<b>Tail:</b>	Long, vertical, pressed to the perch	6 points
<b>Breast:</b>	Breastbone naked, frills not meeting in the center	10 points
<b>Flanks:</b>	Symmetrical on both sides, holding the wings	6 points
<b>Length:</b>	(not stated)	6 points
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100 points</b>
